
County Durham has a thriving, diversified economy with the county having long been a chosen location for businesses looking to invest in the region, from NSK Bearings setting up in 1976 through to Hitachi Rail Europe opening their European HQ for high speed trains in 2015.

The automotive supply chain is particularly strong in volume manufacturing, electronics and precision engineering and includes strategic companies such as Gestamp Tallent, TRW, NSK and Mecaplast. More than 30 companies specialising in this sector employ over 6,000 people. This established manufacturing base of suppliers serves Nissan, Caterpillar and Komatsu as well as supplying other automotive OEMs around the UK.



As well as this strong manufacturing and supply chain base Durham is also home to a wide number of diverse businesses many of which have strong links through R&D with the world renowned Universities in the region.

The science park at NETPark is one example of how County Durham provides opportunities for manufacturers to explore the potential of new technologies and applications. Key partners are CPI and Durham University and capabilities exist, backed by the Catapult programme, in materials integration, nanotechnology and printed electronics.





Location

Jade Park is located less than a minute from the A19 immediately south of Murton, County Durham giving excellent access to Tees Valley, Sunderland, Durham and Newcastle upon Tyne with multimodel transport access to the UK and beyond.


Only 11 miles south of the Nissan manufacturing plant (NMUK Sunderland) it is ideally suited for businesses in automotive manufacturing and supply chain sectors.

Infrastructure

Fully serviced, engineered and level site with first phase infrastructure complete. A new service road links directly to the A19 dual carriageway.

Durham County Council also has a programme of works to increase the capacity of the A19/A182 junctions serving Jade Business Park allowing for future growth. Modelling and preliminary design work is complete and funding is in place to allow ground investigation work in spring 2018 with construction due to complete by the late summer 2019.
