Introduction

Located on the edge of Cramlington, only minutes from the deep-sea Port of Blyth, West Hartford Park offers some of the largest and best-connected industrial, manufacturing, and logistics space in the North East of England.

With space available from 50,000 sq ft to 532,000 sq ft, this 126-acre park is the perfect place for large-scale occupiers needing brand new units that can be built to meet specific occupier requirements, on a freehold or leasehold basis, all with access to significant power provision and high-quality infrastructure.

It also offers businesses, staff and visitors a business park setting like no other where 35% of the site is offered over to green and open spaces, where enhanced biodiversity and business can thrive together.



Port of Blyth

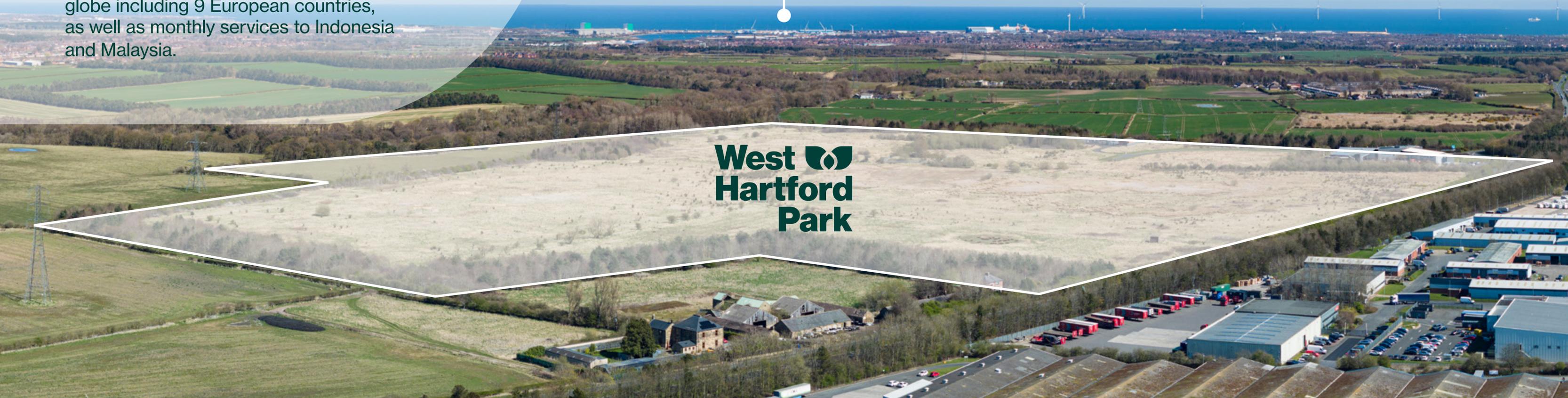
