



The building offers the largest existing office floorplates in Newcastle, with 22,000 sq ft of uninterrupted floorplates, capable of provisioning up to 450 people on a single floor if required.



Bright & Light

The ground floor entrance benefits from an impressive 25m atrium that has been refurbished to an exceptional standard, creating a contemporary welcome for tenants and visitors. One Trinity Gardens now benefits from an onsite restaurant, Fork, owned by one of Newcastle's most impressive food & beverage operators to create a unique, locally-sourced, wholesome menu.

In addition, the building now benefits from a complimentary boutique fitness centre accessible only to tenants, featuring towel-service, personal trainers, 5-star changing facilities and state-of-the-art TechnoGym fitness equipment. The building has been provisioned for the modern occupier, with the inclusion of podcast facilities, E-bike charging, onsite bike and car parking facilities, as well as achieving impressive ESG credentials such as EPC 'A' & WiredScore Platinum, and seeking to compete for the prestigious BCO Design awards in 2025.





High quality refurbished accommodation

Grade A fully refurbished accommodation

One Trinity Gardens has, as of 2024, undergone a comprehensive refurbishment of all common areas and vacant lettable space to deliver the pre-eminent office building in Newcastle city centre. The building benefits from newly-installed LED-lighting, brand new VRF air conditioning system, onsite gym and restaurant facilities, boutique changing-rooms, meeting and podcast space, as well as the largest lettable floorplates in the city.

The building now benefits from an EPC rating 'A', as well as WiredScore Platinum, and is currently seeking Fitwel & BREEAM accreditation, in addition to submitting for BCO design award nominations, to further cement itself of the best-in-class office location in the North East.



The added flexibility of the largest open floorplate in Newcastle, with the benefit of four access points from the core, provides an opportunity to meet a range of requirement sizes where staff can be located on one single floor. The property features a large, modern, manned reception area leading to four 13 person lifts which provides access to all levels. Each floor benefits from dedicated Male, Female and Disabled toilets including shower facilities. The building also benefits from 24/7 security, ready-to-go fibre-optic broadband, and regular onsite placemaking events.

FORK Restaurant

Fork is the latest addition to Newcastle's thriving food scene. Open to tenants and the general public alike, Fork is the brainchild of founder Trevor Davis, with the ethos being to create a truly unique breakfast and lunchtime offering on the Quayside.

The menu will continuously evolve through the seasons to ensure everything offered reflects the best of local produce, while all employees, ingredients, distributors, furniture makers are all from the North East – making Fork a true celebration of the local area.

Our founder, Trevor Davis, has had an illustrious career in cheffing and catering. As well as having worked all over the world, Trevor is an entrepreneur who is founder of some Durham city's most successful bars and eateries. Born and bred in Sandbanks, Poole, to a fishing family, he was raised around food and business. He went on to classically train as a chef and work in some of the UK's top hotels.

He's also served up dishes fit for royalty having worked in Saudi Arabia for the former King and the King's Princes, where he ran the catering operation at many of the palaces.

He moved to Durham 14 years ago after falling in love



with the beauty of the city and has since launched several businesses with his family, including the quirky Old Toms Gin Bar, at The Riverwalk development and the North East's smallest gin bar Tin of Sardines, on Elvet Bridge, Durham – which also has sister venues in Roker, Sunderland and Poole.

Together, with his family, he runs FORK – putting his heart and soul into providing exceptional food and service.


Dynamic Configuration

Strategic Position

One Trinity Gardens occupies a strategic position linking the Quayside to the traditional City Centre, and takes full advantage of all of the Quayside's setting, which is now a well-established employment, leisure and living quarter of the city.

The area immediately surrounding One Trinity Gardens is home to a number of office users, the Law Courts, the Live Theatre and some of Newcastle most highly regarded restaurants including Terry Laybourne's Café 21, St Vincent and Broad Chare venues.



City Centre Locations

Access to the Quayside is excellent with a dedicated Quaylink bus service connecting the area to the City Centre, Central Station and Gateshead Quays. Metro access is available within a short walking distance via Manors Metro Station, and the Quayside itself provides excellent cycle and pedestrian access. Car parking provision is very good, with the Stockbridge MSCP directly opposite, and further parking available within a short walk.
